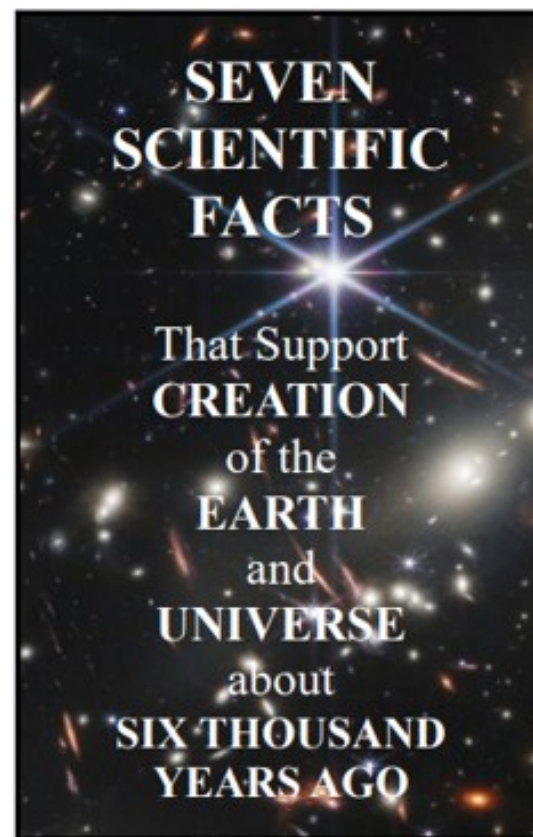

1. Collagen was found in dinosaur bones. That means the bones are less than 10,000 years old, not millions of years old, because collagen would be completely gone after 10,000 years. The Second Law of Thermodynamics states that systems degrade over time.

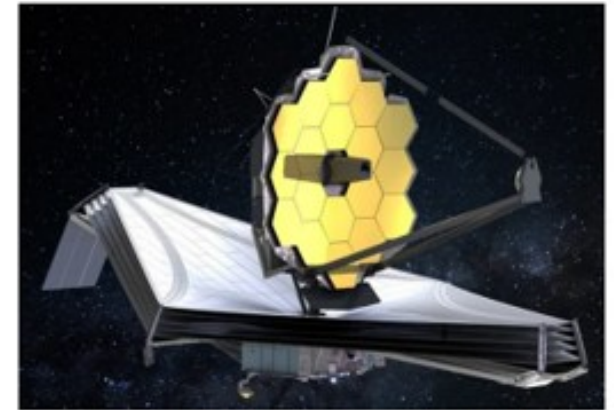
